

Have you been diagnosed with Ulcerative Colitis (UC)?

Are you and currently receiving treatment with mesalamine?

Do you feel that you might be experiencing a flare of your UC, based on noticing the following symptoms?

Your gut is normally home to a large number of bacteria, referred to as gut commensal bacteria, that reside together and play an important role in maintaining your state of health and wellness. The investigational drug being tested in this clinical trial consists of a collection of such gut commensal bacteria that were specifically selected for their potential to benefit patients with ulcerative colitis.
